## How do I know if I'm affected by the MPR?

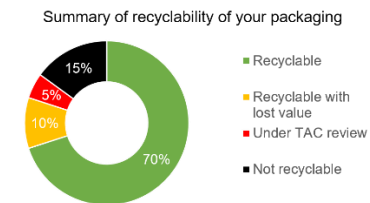
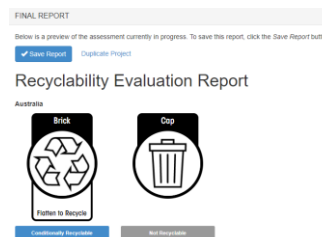
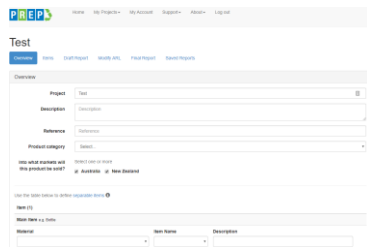

## What is PREP?

PREP stands for Packaging Recyclability Evaluation Portal. It is an online platform. It simulates the waste management ecosystem and determine if packaging is recyclable or not, and why. The platform aggregates details about your packaging and generates the data report at the end of the year.<sup>1</sup> PREP is currently used in four countries: Australia, New Zealand, United-Kingdom, and Singapore.
